# From the Budget Office...

For budget year 2019, the Municipality of Cabatuan expecting an IRA Allocation of One Hundred Forty Seven Million Nine Hundred Eighty Five Thousand Four Hundred Sixty Two Pesos (P147,985.462.00). Only figure is based from the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Local Budget Memorandum No. 77, dated May 15, 2018 which provides guidelines on the preparation of the FY 2019 Annual Budget of LGUs. Computation of the Internal Revenue Allotment (IRA) share is based on the certification of the Bureau of Internal Revenue on the computation of share of LGUs from actual collection of taxes in FY 2016.

The municipal annual budget shall be prepared in accordance with Local Budget Memorandum highlights No.77 which following:

For all that we have accomplished, PESO will continue to fulfill its role in bringing Cabatuananons closer to employment through TESDA trainings.

## LGU-Cabatuan Sustains 150 SPES Beneficiaries

The Special Program for Employment of Students (SPES) has become a helpful program in the lives of many aspiring students of Cabatuan. In the past 3 years, the local government through PESO implemented and administered the SPES Program. This program is an aid for the poor yet deserving students to pursue their education through employing them during summer breaks. The 150 SPES beneficiaries were given a 20-day employment which started on May 11, 2018 to June 2, 2018.

This year, the SPES Beneficiaries were given the task to profile the child labor in the barangay and collect/survey data for KABALAKA Program. Now, the program has kept on progressing and more of the less fortunate yet deserving students are inspired to qualify and to get employed in SPES. SPES also creates an avenue for them to widen their learning experiences, improve their social interaction and be able to serve their fellow Cabatuananons.


The MPDO facilitated the Training on Community Based Monitoring System (CBMS) Module Comprehensive Development Planning last February 12-16, 2018 at Clada Traveller's Inn, Brgy. Tiring, Cabatuan, Iloilo. **CBMS** Module 4 is the formulation of a Comprehensive Development Plan of the Municipality for 2019-2024. The DILG personnel were the resource persons and used the RAPIDS approach in determining the priority project, programs and activities. The participants in the workshop were LGU personnel and NGOs representatives.

These development sectors were also tapped in the formulation of the LDIP 2019-2021 last April 25, 2018.

The MPDO then utilized the LDIP to finalize the Annual Investment Program 2019 which presented to Municipal Development Council (MDC) for approval during their meeting last May 23, 2018. This AIP was forwarded to the office of the Sanguniang Bayan for their adoption.

The MPDO also facilitated the conduct of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan (CLUP) 2017-27 Public Hearing last February 8, 2018. This was attended by PLUC members, SB Members, Department Heads, Land Owners and Businessmen. Suggestions, clarifications, opinions, and recommendations of participants and visitors were noted for consideration.

These are the major accomplishment of the MPDO as part of its contributions to help achieve the vision and dreams of Hon. Ronilo O. Caspe for the Municipality of Cabatuan.
